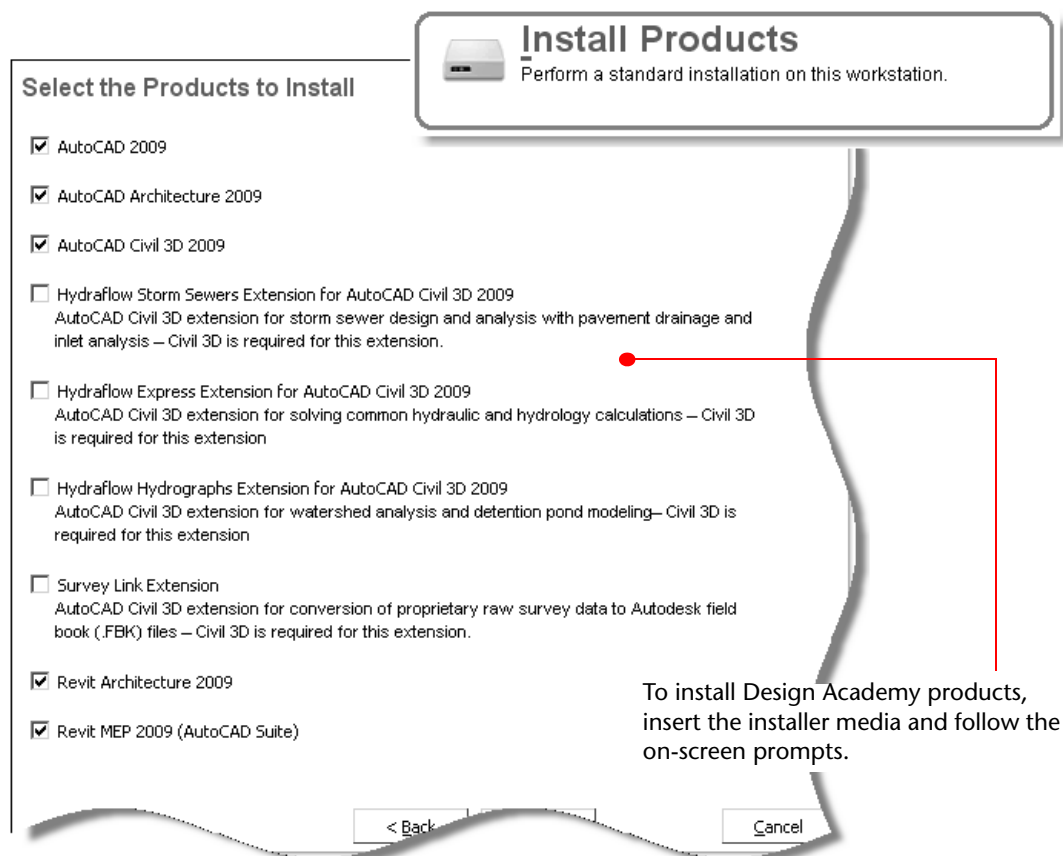
Online Documentation
